Rules and Regulations

- The competition is open for Indonesian citizens and KITAS holders aged between 17 to 30 years old.
- The competition is open for everyone who does not have an experience of working in a kitchen for at least 2 years.
- Participants must be able to speak English fluently.
- Participants are required to create an original recipe for a brand new dish inspired by an Indonesian traditional dish. The recipe must represent innovation and creativity.

Participants are required to include the following details when submitting their recipe:

- Ingredients
- Step by step
- A photo of final product
- A 2-minute video of how to make the dish

- Participants are required to submit their recipe before 9 October 2018, 11:59 Western Indonesian Time.
- Submission after 9 October 2018 will not be entertained.
- Incomplete submissions will not be entertained.



- Qualified participants will advance to the top 16 that will be announced on 12 October 2018.
